



**IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT WOOD SPECIFICATIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:**

Wood is a natural product; no two pieces are the same. All wood contracts when dry and expands when wet, which means that gaps between pickets can vary depending on the weather. We use general industry terms when describing fence materials. For example a 2 x 4 x 8 is in fact 1 ½ x 3 ½ x 8. The six foot pickets we use come in batches of anywhere from 70 ½ inches tall to 72 inches tall. Occasionally, in our Texas weather, what might have been perfectly straight posts, pickets and rails, might eventually warp, twist, bend slightly and even split.

Cedar fence varies from very dark to very light colors which fades with time. We do not guarantee consistency in color. If we repair your fence we cannot match newer wood with older wood. Our warranty only covers splits that go right through the wood; surface splitting is a natural occurrence. We only warranty posts and rails that bend, twist or curve more than 1 ½ inches from straight and pickets that bend or twist more then 3/8 inch. However, we use grade 2 materials for a quality result and we will do our very best to provide a good product and finish. We do not warranty those areas of a fence that are made wet from irrigation.
